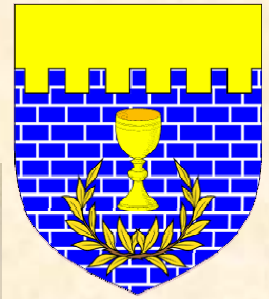

On Saturday, the 12thth of January at the 12th Night Celebration in the Barony of the Citadel of the Southern Pass, the fourth of the Unbelted Tournaments will be fought. The style of the tournament of the day is FLORENTINE, NO MADU. You must be authorized in this weapon style to participate. As is now the usual practice, he who Wins the list will receive a weapon of some type. He who Places will receive silver and lo, he who Shows will receive. something. Don't forget that THL Anastasiia will be on hand to give victors of the list the opportunity to get a better (or worse) prize! Points will be given for Winning, Placing and Showing and do not forget that Most Chivalrous and Best Death on the Field will also receive points. The tournament will be fought best of three, double elimination.

Please remember that to gain entrance into the List, a toy is to go to THL Anastasiia for the Toys for Tots drive

For those of you interested in the standings for the Unbelted Tournaments to =date, after three tournaments, these are the standings;

Directions:

To Tobin Park Methodist Church from the North take I-10 South to TX-375 Loop E/ Transmountain Rd. Take a left on Transmountain Rd (east over the mountain) and follow to Gateway Blvd. S. Take a right (south) on Gateway and follow to Diana Dr. Take a left on Diana Dr. From the NorthEast take Highway 54 (Patriot HWY) into El Paso. Exit at Diana Dr. Take a Left on Diana.

From the South or East exit I-10 at Highway 54 (Patriot HWY) and head north on 54. Exit at Diana Dr. Take a right on Diana.

Then Follow Diana Dr. east to Dyer. Turn Left (north) on Dyer and go one block to Wren. Turn right on Wren. The church is at the intersection of Wren and Roanoke.



To Memorial Park take best route to I-10 and exit at Piedras, which is between Downtown El Paso and Highway 54 Exit. Head north on Piedras to Grant St. Turn right on Grant and follow to Memorial Park.
