Look to Unbelted Tournament #10! The STYLE will be GREATSWORD. The date is the afternoon of the 23rd of August at Nahrun Kabirun's Clann War event. Remember to bring your own weapon for the list.

Also remember that you must be authorized in the weapon style of the day to participate. As is now the usual practice, he who Wins the list will receive a weapon of some type. He who Places will receive silver and lo, he who Shows will receive... something. Don't forget that THL Anastasiia or her representative will be on hand to give victors of the list the opportunity to get a better (or worse) prize!

To gain entrance into these Lists, a toy is to go to THL Anastasiia (or her representative) for the Toys for Tots drive or you may present to her (or her representative) at the time of the List the sum of \$5.00 for her to purchase toys on your behalf. One toy or the price of one toy (\$5.00 minimum) is all you need to enter.

Greetings, all good gentles, and be of good cheer for the Santa Fe Renaissance Fair's inaugural event is here! Come relive the Spanish Renaissance on September 20 and 21, 2008, at the historical Rancho de las Golondrinas, a living history museum with grounds, buildings, and history circa the early 1700s!

Come and join the Shire of Drygestan in representing the Spanish Renaissance to the general public. And get in a Clan Tynker show or two: their troupe has been hired as entertainment for the Fair! Join the Shire of Drygestan in a beef stew meal, cooked by Mistress Helga, on Saturday night, and peruse goods for sale from the SCA merchants in the SCA Village! There will also be merchants and lunch-time food vendors in the main Fair.

## Basic Site Rules:

1. No pets are allowed. This is a strict Golondrinas rule.
  2. Alcohol use is limited to the "SCA Village" and is limited to "off-hours" (the public will be present in our Village between 10AM and 5PM on both days).
  3. No vehicle traffic is allowed on-site between 10AM and 5PM on Saturday and Sunday. Please be prepared to set up your camp and move your vehicle during the "off-hours."
  4. Fire restrictions will be determined by the Santa Fe County Fire Department at the time of the event.
  5. Modern tents are allowed during the night, but they must be taken down and stored by 10AM. The Shire pavilion can be used as a storage space or a sleeping space.
- Combat and archery activities are allowed in the SCA Village only. No members of the public will be allowed to participate in combat or archery activities in the SCA Village. All combat or archery participants must show a valid blue and green card to participate.

Please strive to represent the Spanish Renaissance in your dress, camp, and demeanor (the Spanish Renaissance covers the years of 700 to 1600 AD, throughout the Iberian peninsula, including some parts of Arabia).

For those wanting to camp, please RSVP to THLady Maimuna with your tent's footprint.

Directions to El Rancho de las Golondrinas from al-Barran and points south:

Take your best route to the Santa Fe Relief Route exit 276B off of I-25. Go right off of the exit, so that you are heading north on NM 599 (the Santa Fe bypass). Take your first left at the light (onto the west frontage road). Turn right on Los Pinos Road (about a half-mile down the frontage road). The museum will be 3.2 miles down the road, on the left-hand side.

From Las Cruces: Take Highway 70 to Ruidoso. Turn left on Sudderth Rd. (Highway 37). Drive through town to Mechem Dr.; make a right. Turn left at Cedar Creek Rd.
