As is now the usual practice, he who Wins the list will receive a weapon of some type. He who Places will receive silver and lo, he who Shows will receive... something. Don't forget that THL Anastasiia or her representative will be on hand to give victors of the list the opportunity to get a better (or worse) prize! Points will be given for Winning, Placing and Showing and do not forget that Most Chivalrous and Best Death on the Field will also receive points. The tournament will be fought best of three, double elimination.

Fencing 1 Hour Speed List (Saturday)

Weapons of choice with a 1 minute time limit on each bout. The winner of each bout stays on the field until he is dispatched. Wounds are cumulative. Any bout that goes the 1 minute distance will have both fencers declared as lost and two new fencers will take the field. The winner is declared as the fencer with the most victories.

The 1 Hour Ring of Death (Sunday)

Sponsored by Senor Carlos Nieto de Andrade

This is a one hour weapon of choice tournament open to all. The style of weapons you choose though are the weapons you will fence with throughout the List - if your equipment breaks or fails during the tournament you are required to replace it with similar equipment. There will be no changing of forms.

The object is to challenge fencers of equal or greater station than yourself. At 30 minutes, a 5 minute recess will be taken. Combat will resume until the time has expired or there is only one person who is still able to fight on the field. In the case of a tie at the end of the fight the remaining fighters will be polled as to how the remainder of the List will be fought.

-Each combatant will be clearly marked as his or her rank since this will be challenge based combat.

-Each combatant has 5 tokens to start with.

-Every time you are killed, you must report to the MoL and state who killed you. A token will be removed from your count and added to your opponents. When you are out if tokens, you are removed from the List.

-A fighter may refuse a fight but will still loose a token to the fighter who challenged him or her.

-If you are not able to continue fighting due to exhaustion, you should remove yourself from the field.

-Fencers are encouraged to doff their masks and drink when necessary but if challenged are to return to the field as soon as possible to resume the combat.

Rank is defined based on any or the highest award for that style of combat, specifically:
No award, Baronial fencing award, Kingdom AoA fencing, Grant fencing award (DWS)

Pas d' Arms (Saturday)

Banners ARE required!

Closed face helms are ENCOURAGED!

NO thrusting.

A Consort IS required!

NO exposed plastic armor.

There will be a processional, and helmets will be presented on a table. The consorts starting from lowest precedence fighter to highest will challenge their fighters opponent by tapping their helmet.

Single or double elimination depending on the number of fighters. The bouts will be counted blows to 3 with no wounds.
