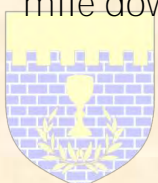
Directions to the Saturday site:

Take Exit 21 toward Trowbridge Sr/Altura Ave. 0.3 mi. Stay straight to go onto Gateway Blvd N. Turn right onto Bliss Ave. 0.3 mi Turn right onto Hardaway St. 0.1 m.

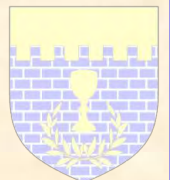
Directions to the Sunday site:

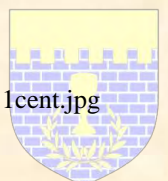
