SITE IS WET AFTER 5 PM. BYOB, and please drink responsibly.

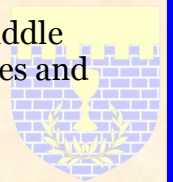

From points north, take I-10 East bound to Patriot Freeway/US-54 E exit, Exit 22B, toward Alamo-gordo/Ft. Bliss 1.0 mi. Stay straight to go onto US-54 N/Patriot Fwy 0.1 mi. Take Exit 21 toward Trowbridge Sr/Altura Ave. 0.3 mi. Stay straight to go onto Gateway Blvd N. Turn right onto Bliss Ave. 0.3 mi Turn right onto Hardaway St. 0.1 m.

SUNDAY SCHEDULE

War Practice is expected to begin about 10 AM at Memorial Park, 1701 Copia Street; any changes will be announced in evening court on Saturday.

Directions to the Sunday site:

Take I-10 to the Piedras Exit. Head North toward the mountains; take the first right after you cross the railroad tracks (Grant Avenue). About a third of a mile down Grant, on your left, is a circular parking area where we meet.
