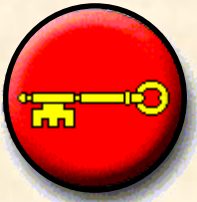
Also, please remember that not all wounds are visible.

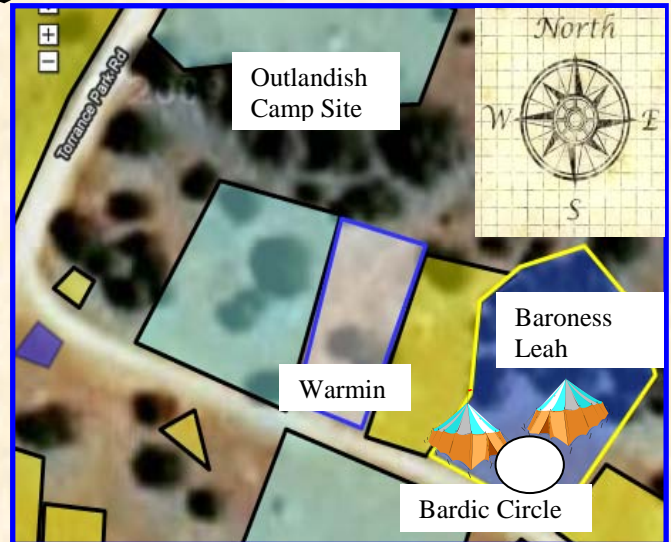
