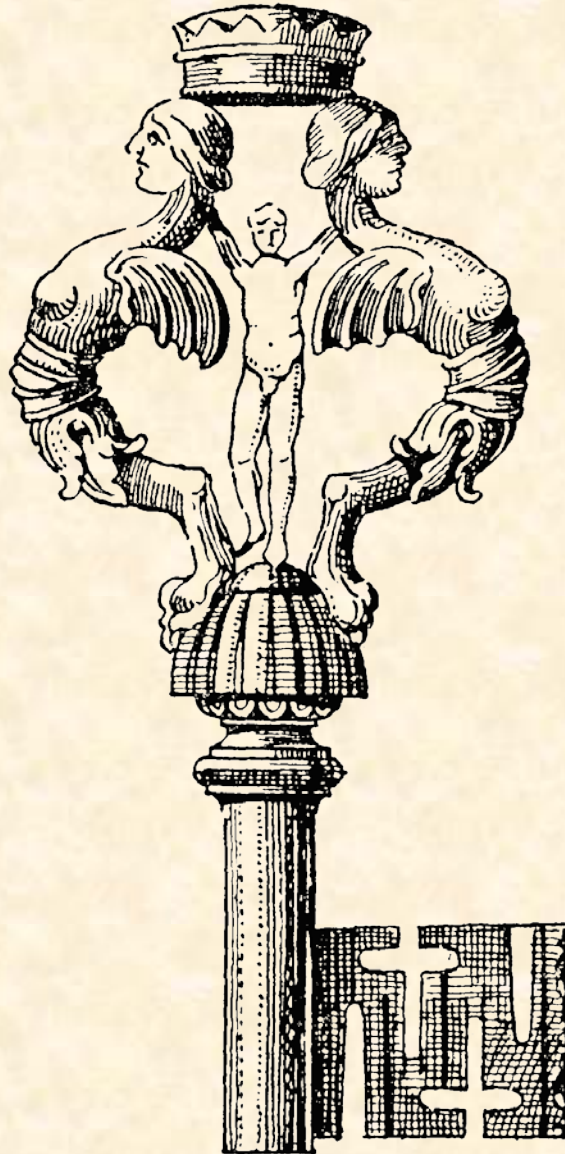

*not yet in school...*

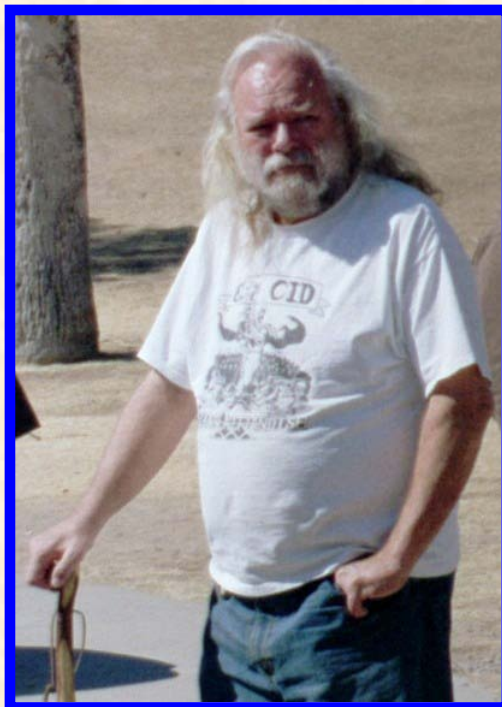
*or hadn't even been born yet!*
