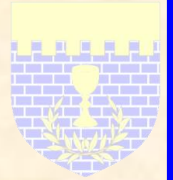

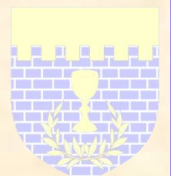

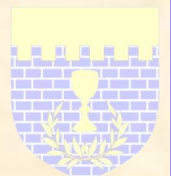

4:00 p.m. Site closes.

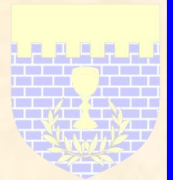
